
DIRECTIONS FOR INSTALLING SEAM SUPPORTS

Please break the supports into 3 inch strips by bending at the score lines using both hands in a back and forth motion.

(Each full pad contains 8 three-inch wide strips)

<u>BEFORE</u> STARTING: If you are installing metal supports into copper gutters, you must use a piece of duct tape extending ½" beyond each end of each individual strip to prevent copper/aluminum reaction!!!

1. Bend up the ends (approx. ½ inch) at a ninety-degree angle using your thumb and index finger as shown in Figure 1. Make sure the black side faces up.



2. Install support after you place the Flo-Free into the gutter but before you position Flo-Free under the front lip of the gutter. See Figure 2. The black side should be facing the Flo-Free.



3. Simply bend an arch and slip the support into the front lip of the gutter. The black side is now facing the sky. Tuck the Flo-Free into the lip of the gutter and into the support. See Figures 3a and 3b.



4. Supports should be installed at the seams and/or every 18". You should space them away from any gutter brackets that may be near the support...at least 6" away from such brackets unless the Flo-Free seam is closer than 6". The supports are standard black coil stock cut to 3" by the width of the Flo-Free (i.e. 10 ½", 8 ½").
